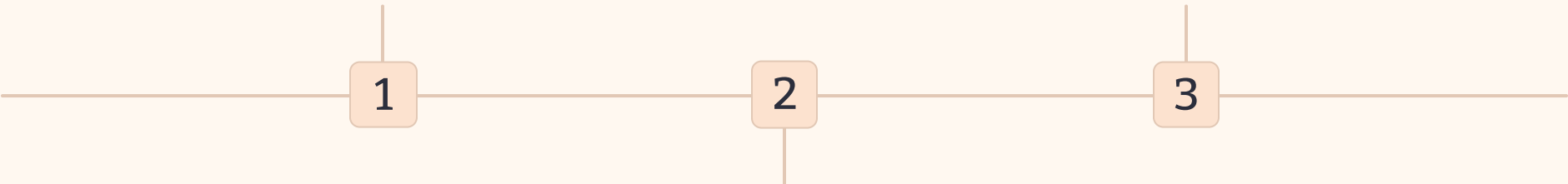

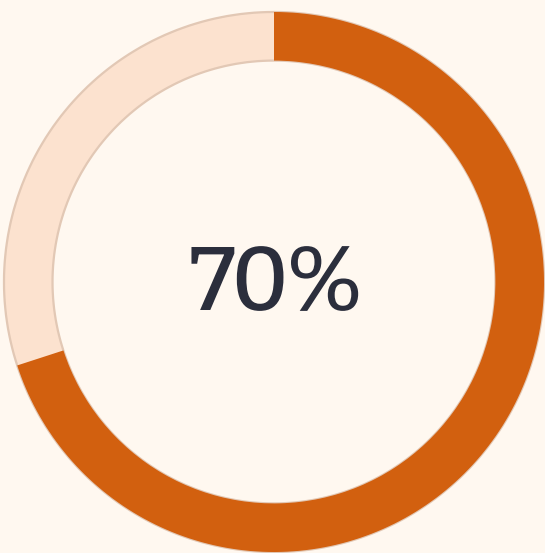

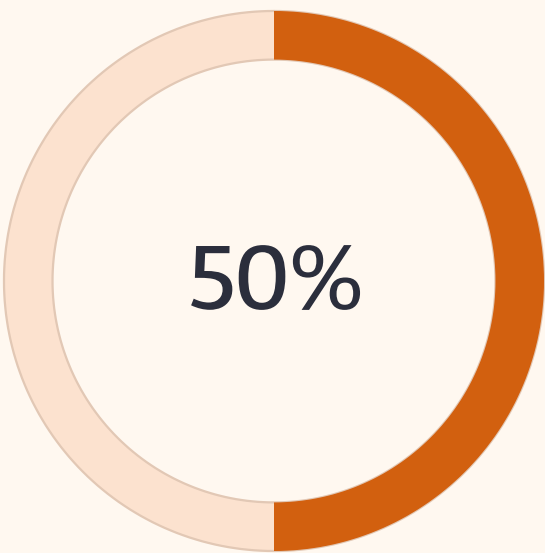
The Aging Process in Large-Breed Dogs

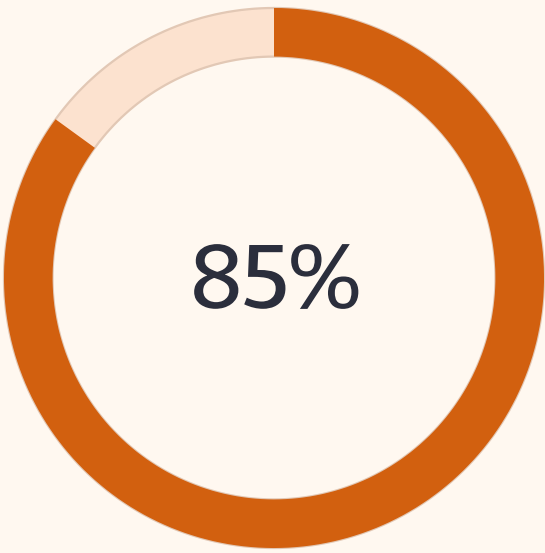
